Year End 2009 FRS Data Warehouse Processing Schedule**

During the fiscal yearend period, data in the FRS Data Warehouse tables shift between the various tables. See the table below to determine where specific data is according to the inquiry date.

All FRS table names begin with WFRS:

The Delphi data warehouse that supports the CIS application, the WHRS data tables and the WFRS data tables that are used for ad-hoc reporting by the campus community will have restricted access after July, 2009 and will be decommissioned on October 1, 2009. The Delphi data warehouse will be replaced by the Operational Data Store (ODS). The ODS will support the same reporting tools, such as MS-Access and other ODBC connected applications, that have been used against the Delphi data warehouse. Campus users that are using these reporting tools will need to modify their reports to access the new data tables and views in the ODS. At this time, the ODS contains student data, human resource data, job account data, legacy WFRS data and the data structures with test data for the new Quali Financial System.

The ODS dictionary can be viewed by logging into the CAP Portal (cap.is.colostate.edu) and accessing the Campus Reporting/ODS Tab. The data structures currently exist in the dictionary, but several of the Table and Column descriptions are missing. These descriptions are being created and updated as quickly as possible and should be complete soon. The campus user community will be notified as additional data is defined and available in the ODS. Notifications for structure and dictionary updates will be sent to the ODS listserv. If you are not currently a member of the listserv, you can join by going to the ACNS home page (www.acns.colostate.edu) and accessing the Mailing Lists/non-course related listserv and subscribing to the ODS_L list.

Oracle Discoverer Plus is a centrally supported web based reporting tool that is available for use by the campus community to access the data in the ODS. All existing user accessible data views in ODS are available through Discoverer Plus and additional views are being created as new data is added. Many users on campus currently use Discoverer Plus to manage ad-hoc reporting of student and human resource data. Discoverer Plus training is provided by CTSS and there is a Discoverer and ODS user's group on campus where reporting needs can be identified and shared among users.

If you are a Delphi user with WFRS table access and you currently have an ODS account, your ODS account has been given access to the WFRS tables and the new Quali data table structures. If you are a Delphi user with WFRS table access and you do not have an ODS account, please contact Information Systems and an account will be created for you in ODS and will be granted access to the WFRS tables and the new Quali data table structures.

Information Systems will work with the campus user community and the central data authorities to assess the data requirements and successfully transition the campus ad-hoc reporting needs from Delphi to ODS.
